Pre-Watching Activity: Show SS the first page. Discuss SS's answers and opinions. This can be done in pairs, small teams or as a whole class activity.

Reading/Speaking: Invite SS to solve the quiz in pairs/teams/whole class.

Writing/Speaking (10-15 min): Invite SS to create a similar quiz about games/yt/TikTok or any other internet phenomenon. This can be done individually, in pairs or teams. Later the groups exchange quizzes and try to solve them.

Video:

Let SS read the questions and make sure they understand them. You might want to invite your SS to guess what the video is going to be about.
